Treatment of a hematoma under the eye should be started as soon as possible after injury, attaching ice or a cold object to the damaged area for twenty to thirty minutes. Constriction under the influence of cold blood vessels prevents further spread of the hematoma.

Take care not to press on the eye itself. Apply cold as soon as possible after the injury to reduce swelling. Repeat several times a day for a day or two. Look for blood. If you see it in the white or colored parts of the eye, seek urgent care by an eye specialist (ophthalmologist).

An eye hemorrhage is a condition where blood vessels inside the eye rupture and bleed, leaving red splotches on the white of the eye, in the retina, or between the retina and the lens. Diabetes, high blood pressure, and eye strain are some factors that can cause eye hemorrhages. Bleeding in the eye is, however, often without an obvious cause and sometimes can occur from everyday incidents, such as sneezing, coughing, or eye-rubbing.

A hematoma on the skin like your muscle joints are often diagnosed by a physical exam because naked eyes can see them. Generally, there is no special test of blood that is used to check hematomas. Your doctors can recommend a test containing the complete blood count (CBC), chemistry panel, coagulation, and a liver test to get a hematoma checked.

External examination: lid trauma, periorbital bruising and facial fractures. Pupils: RAPD in some cases, e.g. retinal detachment, vitreous hemorrhage or retrobulbar hemorrhage.
