Scoring GARS-2: Subscale Standard Scores and the Autism Index
Make sure all items in each subscale have been rated
Add raw scores for each item & total these
Find %ile rank and standard score for each subscale
Standard score (SS) of 7 or higher on a subscale indicates a very likely possibility of Autism (based on a mean of 10; standard deviation (SD) of 3)
SS of 4-6 on a subscale indicates a possibility of Autism
SS of 0-3 on a subscale indicates Autism is ...

GARS subtest raw scores are converted into standard scores, which are then summed and in turn converted to an Autism Quotient (AQ). Subtest standard scores of 8 and above, and AQs of 90 and above, are associated with 'Average' and above probabilities of the subject being a person with an ASD.

It is done by your primary healthcare provider, a teacher or a parent by rating the child's behaviors from 1 to 4. 1 being normal for your child's age, 2 for mildly abnormal, 3 for moderately abnormal and 4 as severely abnormal. Scores range form 15 to 60 with 30 being the cutoff rate for a diagnosis of mild autism.

CARS scores range from 15 to 60, and the cutoff point for an autism diagnosis is a score of 30 or above. Scores falling within the range for a diagnosis of autism are broken down further to reflect the degree in which symptoms are present. According to the scoring standards of CARS, scores between 30 and 37 indicate mild to moderate autism and ...
