If the stock is up by $\frac{1}{2}$ (\$0.50) when he or she sells, the day trader makes \$500, minus a commission. If our trader is using Scottrade, a popular online trading platform, the commission for stock transactions can range from \$7 to \$27, giving our trader a net profit in the range of \$493 to \$473. Of course, we have to take taxes into consideration.
