Intellectual Property | Trading Secrets

Trade secrets are intellectual property(IP) rights on confidential information which may be sold or licensed. In general, to qualify as a trade secret, the information must be: commercially valuable because it is secret, be known only to a limited group of persons, and. be subject to reasonable steps taken by the rightful holder of the information to keep it secret, including the use of confidentiality agreements for business partners and employees.

A trade secret: is information that has either actual or potential independent economic value by virtue of not being generally known, has value to others who cannot legitimately obtain the information, and. is subject to reasonable efforts to maintain its secrecy.

Not all uses of trade secrets are considered misappropriation. In order to be liable for misappropriation, the person who uses your trade secret information must have either: 1) obtained the information improperly, such as through corporate spying or 2) used the trade secret, which arose from a breach of confidence, such as where trade secret information was obtained through an employment relationship.
