But the pride is merited: Vermejo, which is about a quarter of the size of Yellowstone, has a higher density of bison (totaling about 2,500 during calving season) and elk (8,000) than the Wyoming landmark, but it gets only a couple thousand visitors each year, as compared with the national park's four million.
