If some contracts are expired or have an end-date before the General Availability (GA) date for vSphere 7U1, you will not be eligible to upgrade your licenses to VMware vSphere 7U1 for the quantities on those contracts.

First of all verify VMware ESXi 6.7 compatibility with your server platform (Check it exactly and also generation of your Server). If nothing has been shown about it, i suggest to don't try to customize and upgrade it to version 6.7 (Try older versions like 6.0 6.5, they are still supported).

After we have upgraded our vCenter from 5.0 to 6.x, we now need to upgrade our ESXi hosts. We can upgrade using an ESXi ISO image directly boot the host and manually go through the process and upgrade the ESXi, or we can use the VMware Update Manager to do this automatically.

19 th September 2018 will be the end of general support for VMWare vSphere 5.5, this also includes vSphere Hypervisor ESXi 5.5, vCenter Server 5.5 and vSAN 5.5. In order for customers to preserve their full level of support and subscription services, VMware recommends that any customers using vSphere 5.5 upgrade to a newer version, between vSphere 6.5 and 6.7 as soon as possible.

Upgrade vSphere licensing from vSphere 5.x to vSphere 6.x. from the myvmware portal. Apply the new vSphere 6.x licenses to your vCenter Server and then to your ESXi hosts. There will be a 60 day grace period during the upgrade or migration to allow for the license upgrade.

VMware vSphere 5 is available exclusively on the vSphere ESXi hypervisor architecture. ESXi is the latest hypervisor architecture from VMware and, as of the vSphere 4.1 release, VMware's recommended best practice when deploying VMware vSphere. Users can upgrade to ESXi (from ESX) as part of an upgrade to vSphere 5.
